1) Courses/Seminars/Conferences/Practice Education	Credit Allocation	Annual Credit Limit (per year) & Conditions*
a) BCAK Professional Development events & registered courses	1-credit/hr or as indicated	No limit
b) Healthcare Professional Conferences (CKA, NSCA, CAE, CSEP, NIDMAR, CMHA, ACSM, etc.)	1-credit/hr	No limit
c) Professional Kinesiology Training Courses/Workshops/In-services	1-credit/hr	No limit
d) Registered Online education courses and webinars	1-credit/hr	No limit
e) Post-Secondary Courses in Kinesiology or a related healthcare discipline	1-credit/hr	No limit Typical course – 30 hrs class time = 30 *Must pass the course
f) First Aid, CPR/AED	1 credit/hr	Maximum 5 credits
h) Business courses for kinesiology professional practice ⁱⁱ	1-credit/3hrs	Maximum 10 credits
2) Service to the Profession	Credit Allocation*	Max 10 credits / year cumulative of sub-categories
a) Presenting on kinesiology practice at professional conferences or educational events	1-credit/hr	*Inclusive of Preparation and Presentation
b) Presenting research/defending a thesis at a healthcare conference		
c) BCAK Officer or Committee Chair	7 credits	Available only for the last year of membership before lapsing, if not already used.
d) BCAK Director at large	5 credits	
e) BCAK General Meeting Attendance & Participation (Voting)	5 credits

ⁱⁱ Includes: Financial management, human resources, IT, health and safety, business management & law as these pertain to the profession of kinesiology and/or related allied healthcare.

Reinstating members must provide proof of continuing professional development courses for review and acceptance by BCAK. Note that one-topic credits will only be considered for a max of 50% of the requirements (e.g. if you require 60 CPD credits to reinstate then 30 (or 50%) can be in one topic (e.g. pilates) and the balance must be in another topic.
